REPORT OF METRO RAIL MEETING – 12 FEBRUARY 2020

Tunnelling & Trucks

1. Tunnelling is expected to start in May – June.
2. Trucks will remove the material from Edmund Herring Oval at night between 7pm and 5am, seven nights a week travelling into Domain Road, turning left into Dallas Brooks Drive, Birdwood Avenue and on.
3. Eighteen trucks, six loads a night.
4. It is expected that this will enable all material to be removed at night, but if the quantity of material being produced is excessive or there is any interruption to the nights activities, some trucks will have to operate during the day and travel along Domain Road, Park Street and Toorak Road West and cope with the traffic.

Village ‘Pop Up’

5. Metro Rail survey results generally favourable.
6. No decision yet whether it will be extended in front of Botanical.
7. Whether and how long it remains is controlled by Council.
8. MSYRG have sought a number of specific answers from Council including what steps have been taken to determine any negative impacts on residents.

Excavation

9. Excavation of the north, south and middle boxes in St Kilda Road is proceeding as planned.
10. The cross tunnel in Toorak Road West near St Kilda Road will be constructed underground.
