MSYRG SUBMISSION IS IN

On Friday 11th December MSYRG lodged with the City of Melbourne our submission to the review. The last three months particularly involved hard work and the valuable assistance of Paul McSweeney and James Syme. Earlier in the year several members volunteered to be Street Representatives and walked the full length of our South Yarra streets carefully noting discrepancies and new information

This MSYRG Submission included a lengthy report from our heritage consultant, Nigel Lewis, and we are confident it will be a significant addition to the work being undertaken by council's own consultant. Our main concern was to ensure none of our heritage properties were missed and in addition we requested a number of changes to the Planning Scheme to better protect our heritage. This has been MSYRG's most important project for the past 10 years.

FAWKNER PARK EASTERN ENTRANCE AT PASLEY STREET NORTH IMPROVEMENTS

Heritage Council Victoria, following a Permit Review Hearing in October, determined on 8th December that a permit should be granted in respect of the Permit Application, subject to conditions.
