THEFTS FROM CARS AND PROPERTIES in PARK ST and DOMAIN ROAD

A PARK ST RESIDENT HAS INFORMED MSYRG OF NUMEROUS BREAK-INS TO CARS PARKED ON PARK ST AND DOMAIN ROAD. The criminal is quite brazen and enters cars around 7pm, is known to sit in them, rifle around the glove box and inner areas of the car and then, up to 20 mins later, casually go to the boot and remove further items. One resident has had his car broken in to on two occasions and at least 7 others in Park St have had their cars broken in to. The police have confirmed attempts on other cars in the vicinity of Park St and Domain Roads and sometimes up to 13 a day. The police believe the same criminal will come back in about a month's time to try again.

As well, in January, there were at least two house break-ins in PARK ST via the rear lane but by a different criminal.

New Food and Garden collection service coming soon

City of Melbourne is introducing a food and garden waste collection service for more than 9000 houses and single-storey apartment blocks. Many households in South Yarra have already received a letter with the details. This is the first stage of a municipal-wide roll out, as part of our commitment to improve our waste and recycling services and reduce the amount of waste going to landfill.

New lime green lidded bin swill be delivered to homes in June, along with a kitchen caddy and compostable caddy liners for food waste. Bin collection days will stay the same, but there will be a change to the frequency of collections.
