2.	Sun/Transurban Run for the Kids . Herald Sun/Transurban Run for the Kids is coming up on Sunday March 17, 2024 and we want to ensure that you're aware of the impact the event may have on you.
	There will be a number of road closures to manage participant and spectator movements during the event.

Our objective is to close roads for the shortest possible time, and we are focused on minimising disruption wherever possible. There will be a significant impact on traffic in and around the course during the event, with road closures in place to ensure the safety of participants. There is no parking on the course itself during the road closure period. At all times emergency access and the movement of emergency vehicles takes priority.
