

CRG Domain Precinct Meeting, 30 October 2024.

- 1. Works on Domain Road are nearly completed, except for a pedestrian crossing that will be finalised this week. Edmund Herring Oval has been restored to original condition, but will be fenced off for a few weeks more while the grass is established.
- 2. Retail Spaces. Only one of the three spaces inside the station concourse has been let and it will be a 7/11. The kiosk on the tram stop platform has not yet been let.
- 3. Areas of responsibility maps: The location of Anzac station at the border of two municipalities means that there is quite a complicated map to define who is responsible for what area. The following two maps show the current situation, where much is maintained by the CYP and the eventual situation when it has been handed back to the councils. This would be helpful in determining who to contact if you notice something amiss, or where to send any Snap, Send, Solve photos taken in the area.
