- 1.Full closure of Domain Road between St Kilda Road and Dalas Brooks Drive between 03.45-11.30 am. Local Access provided
- 2.Park Street remains open but no access from Domain Road into Park Street
3. Full closure of Anderson Street from Domain Road to Alexandra Avenue between 03.45 – 12 pm. Local Access provided
4. Full closure of Alexandra Avenue from Swan Street bridge to Punt Road between 0.35am – 1.00pm
